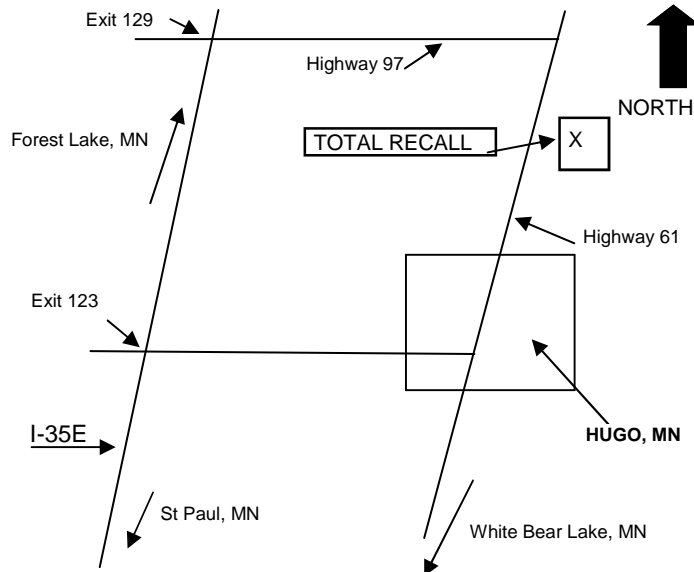

Referencing Dogs on Premises that are Not Entered in Show

Chapter 11, Section 11: “Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts, except that dogs engaged as a special attraction with the American Kennel Club approval may be present. There shall be no benching, nor offering for sale or breeding, nor any displaying of un-entered dogs.”

****NOTICE** No dogs shall be left unattended in a locked car!**

NO REFUND OF ENTRY FEES will be given to the entrants of bitches in season on the days of this show.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.

TELEPHONE, EMAIL, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

POST DATED CHECKS, AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card.

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES.

FAX ENTRIES FOR THIS SHOW WILL BE ACCEPTED UP TO THE CLOSING TIME AND DATE. The Fax Entry number is **320-963-6087**. Official AKC Entry Forms must be used and both sides of the entry form must be transmitted. Credit Card issuer's name (**Visa or Master Card only**), credit card number, expiration date, cardholder's name, and signature must appear on a cover page. The Fax Entry System fee is \$2.50 per class per show in addition to entry fees. **All entries, regardless of method of submission, using a credit card as a method of payment will be processed through the Fax Entry System and are charged the additional fee.** Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
