CONFORMATION CLASSES

All dogs entered in these shows must be individually registered with the AKC. See AKC Rules Applying To Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 1—(Effective January 1, 2010)

Bred-By-Exhibitor Classes The person handling a dog in the Bred By Exhibitor class must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record. Chapter 3, Section 8 AKC Rules Applying To Dog Shows. (Effective January 1, 2005)

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Non-Regular Classes* . . . Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERANS: Open to dogs and bitches 8 years old or older. Dogs are judged separately from bitches and the winner of each of the Veterans Classes is eligible to compete for Best of Variety.

* **Note** . . . "Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competition beyond Best of Breed" . . . AKC Rules Applying to DOG SHOWS, Chapter 11, Section 8. Winners of the Veterans Classes may compete for Best of Breed, if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their **AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER** on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, (919) 816-3776.

Be sure all information is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

(A) Novice. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

(B) Open. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

(C) Master. This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

***NOTICE: Junior Showmanship will be offered both Saturday & Sunday. A Best Junior Handler Rosette & trophy will be awarded each day regardless of the number of entries in the Junior Classes.**
