## **ENTRY FEES**

### **Make sure your entry amount is totaled correctly.**

The Show Secretary will not issue refunds for less than \$10.00. So, CHECK AND DOUBLE-CHECK YOUR ENTRY FORM!

Each First Conformation & Obedience Entry Fee includes a \$0.50 AKC Recording Fee.

Each Recordable Conformation & Obedience Entry Fee includes a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee.

Each Rally Entry Fee includes a \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee.

If the same dog is entered in more than one class, the highest priced class is considered the first entry.

Canadian and International Exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. funds.

**NOTE:** The 12-18 month class is NOT a Puppy Class and is not eligible for the reduced entry fee.

AN AKC RECORDING FEE of \$0.50 and an Event Service Fee of \$3.00 is required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trail or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only and the AKC Event Service Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). [There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.] An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 is required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally Event, the AKC Recording Fee is collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3) All fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

**AKC Rules Applying To Dog Shows - Effective January 1, 2010**

**Chapter 11, Section 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES.**

**RETURNED, REFUNDED, POST-DATED CHECKS OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS** do not constitute valid entry fees and must be made good by cash or money order before the dog(s) will be allowed to be exhibited. The show secretary will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned or otherwise invalid check or declined credit card.

**NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.**

**FAX ENTRIES FOR THIS SHOW WILL BE ACCEPTED UP TO THE CLOSING TIME AND DATE.** The Fax Entry number is 320-963-6087. Official AKC Entry Forms must be used and both sides of the entry form must be transmitted. Credit Card issuer's name (**Visa or Master Card only**), credit card number, expiration date, cardholder's name, and signature must appear on a cover page. As of January 1, 2004, the Fax Entry System fee is \$2.50 per class per show in addition to entry fees. **All entries, regardless of method of submission, using a credit card as a method of payment will be processed through the Fax Entry System and are charged the additional fee. **TELEGRAPH, EMAIL, TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES** cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable.

**NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED** which specifies any conditions as to acceptance.

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

**BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR CLASSES**

Following Best of Breed judging there will be a competition for Best Puppy in Regular Puppy Classes.

**BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR**

Following Best of Breed judging there will be a competition for Best Bred By Exhibitor competition from the Regular Bred By Exhibitor Classes.

**AWARDS OF MERIT**

After the Best of Breed, Best of Winners and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed are judged, the remaining dogs in the ring will stay (including Best of Opposite to Best of Breed, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch for the judge to award "Awards of Merit" to no more than five of the Best of Breed entry. This special award will be given to any dogs or bitches that the judge considers to be "almost" of equal quality to the Best of Breed winner. This is a Non-Regular Award. It does NOT mean the judge has to award five awards nor will they be chosen in any order. It should be emphasized that the Award of Merit is to be given ONLY to those dogs that very closely approach the overall quality of the Best of Breed winner.

**SELECT DOG-SELECT BITCH**

After Best of Breed, Best of Winners and Best of Opposite Sex are judged, the remaining Champions of Record will stay in the ring. The judge may award Select Dog and/or Select Bitch from among the Champions of Record . The award of Select Dog or Select Bitch is at the sole discretion of the Judge. **AKC Grand Championship Ranking System—2010 Oct AKC Board of Directors Minutes**

Without objection the Board approved a new Grand Championship Ranking System, effective immediately. The Grand Champion Ranking system will allow exhibits to continue to accumulate points through the end of the year and the Top 25 winners will be determined and recognized by the largest number of points accumulated by Breed.

In addition, in January 2011 a category for the Top 10 Grand Champion pointed dogs by breed in each state will be available as an added accomplishment to the dog's record. Continuing in May 2011, levels of recognition that include Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum awards of achievement to exhibits obtaining a predetermined number of points for each level of awards will be available. These awards will not be considered a title.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES . . . Involving Multiple Dog Entries**

**NOTE:** As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch and Brace Class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to complete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

**STUD DOG** - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. The Stud dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, and **MUST** be shown in the ring with the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed. Get only to be judged on the merits of the Get. Each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition. Entry fee for Stud Dog is \$25.00

**BROOD BITCH** - Same as Stud Dog Class, except replace "Stud Dog" with "Brood Bitch" and "Get" with "Produce."

*\*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."*

**BRACE CLASS** - (Each Brace shall be composed of two Miniature Pinschers owned by identical owners). The dogs comprising the Brace must be named at time of entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms and a regular entry fee must be paid for the individual dog as well as the fee for the unit. An entry form for a dog entered in a regular class or veteran class or Best of Breed Competition and entered as part of a brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes, "Brace Class." If more than one brace is entered by same owner, the dogs comprising each brace must so designated - "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc. Entry fee for Brace Class is \$25.00

**TEAM CLASS** - (Each Team shall be composed of four Miniature Pinschers owned by identical owners). The dogs comprising the Team must be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Team Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms and a regular entry fee must be paid for the individual dog as well as the fee for the unit. An entry form for a dog entered in a regular or veteran class or Best of Breed Competition and entered as part of a Team must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes, "Team Class." If more than one team is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each team must be so designated - "Team No. 1," "Team No. 2," etc. Entry fee for team class is \$25.00

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 12 years and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 15 years ad under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

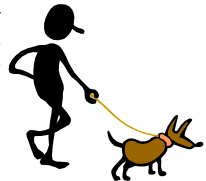
**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 9 years old and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 12 years ad under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

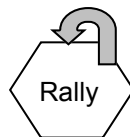

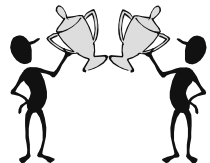
