**MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO . . . Cindy O'Hare, Show Secretary.** CANADIAN EXHIBITORS must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Tabulate carefully.

**POST DATED CHECKS, AND RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card.
