A collection fee will be added to the amount of each returned check. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Dog Shows By Design assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Tabulate carefully.

FAX ENTRIES FOR THIS SHOW WILL BE ACCEPTED UP TO THE CLOSING TIME AND DATE. The Fax Entry number is 320-963-6087. Official AKC Entry Forms must be used and both sides of the entry form must be transmitted. Credit Card issuer's name (**Visa or Master Card only**), credit card number, expiration date, cardholder's name, and signature must appear on a cover page. As of January 1, 2004, the Fax Entry System fee is \$2.50 per class per show in addition to entry fees. **All entries, regardless of method of submission, using a credit card as a method of payment will be processed through the Fax Entry System and are charged the additional fee.** Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission.

POST DATED CHECKS, RETURNED CHECKS AND DECLINED CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES except when being judged.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that Show is over, and the Secretary advised at once. The Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed at the show . . . If not, they become the property of the Show Giving Club. NO TROPHIES will be mailed.

Note . . . "Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competition beyond Best of Breed" . . . AKC Rules Applying to DOG SHOWS, Chapter 11, Section 8. Winners of the Veterans Classes may compete for Best of Breed, if otherwise undefeated on the day of the Show.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

AWARD OF MERIT - At the discretion of the judge, an Award of Merit may be given to 10% (always rounded downward) of all those competing for Best of Breed. The 10% figure shall be based on the total Best of Breed entry at the time of closing, i.e. disregarding absentees or transfers from the classes, plus two for WD and WB, plus an additional number for each winner of the following classes: Veteran Dog, 8-10 yrs.; Veteran Dog, 10 yrs. & older; Veteran Bitch, 8-10 yrs. and Veteran Bitch 10 yrs. & older. All of those in Best of Breed Competition shall be eligible to receive an Award of Merit, except the Best of Breed winner and the Best of Opposite Sex winner.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES . . . Involving Multiple Dog Entries

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Stud dog to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee, this being the regular \$25.00 if entered in Stud Dog only, or \$20.00 if the Stud Dog is entered in another class first. Neutered Stud Dogs are eligible for entry in this class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. Spayed Brood Bitches are eligible for entry in this class.

BRACE CLASS - For two dogs owned and/or co-owned by the exhibitor. Brace will require a fee of \$5.00 as a unit, provided the dogs are entered in another class. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each such dog on an individual regular entry form and a separate fee of \$25.00 must be paid for each such dog entered. Dogs comprising the Brace must be named at time of entry. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, they MUST be indicated as "Brace #1", "Brace #2", etc. PLEASE SUBMIT BRACE ENTRIES TOGETHER.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed/Variety by virtue of having won these classes.

PLEASE NOTE: Judging of Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes will take place prior to Best of Breed competition at both Specialties

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
