

ROUTES TO THE SHOW SITE



FROM THE NORTH: Take I-35W to Stinson Blvd. exit. Turn South on Stinson and continue to Broadway, go right (West) on Broadway about 1 1/2 blocks to the first driveway on right, after the "BREDE" sign. Entrance is in back of building at lower level.

FROM THE SOUTH or WEST: Take I-35W North. to the New Brighton Blvd/Highway 88 exit. Turn right on New Brighton Blvd. Turn left after 1 block on Broadway St. Drive. 2-1/2 blocks to the driveway immediately after 2101 Broadway.

FROM THE EAST: Take I-94 to Hwy. 280. Go North to the Hennepin/Larpenteur Exit & turn left. Turn right on Industrial Blvd. Turn left on Broadway. Proceed about 1 1/2 miles to 2101 Broadway.

EXHIBITORS . . . PLEASE NOTE

Closing Date for entries . . . **12 NOON, Wednesday, February 24, 2010**, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.

Post Dated, Returned Checks or Declined Credit Cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check or declined credit card.

Telegraph, telephone, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted.

Entries not on an official AKC Entry Form and photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the AKC Official Entry Form are not acceptable. **Entries received without fees** will not be accepted.

Make checks/money orders payable to Cindy O'Hare, Event Secretary. Please mail checks/money orders with entries. The Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. **Canadian Exhibitors** make fees payable in U.S. Funds.

Mail all entries with fees to Show Secretary: Cindy O'Hare, 8221 Griffith Ave NW, Maple Lake, MN 55358. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with entry identification cards. The person accompanying the dog to the show must show this identification before the dog will be received. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary at 320-963-7705.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, excused, disqualified by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

Errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whomever shall make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date.

No refund of duplicate entries.

The Wright County Minnesota Kennel Club, Inc., does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.

Management is NOT responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

Consult judging program for time of judging.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners/agents are responsible for having their dogs in the judging rings when classes are called. The Show-giving Club and the Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing services through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling/locating dogs.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates unless they are being judged or in the exercise ring.

Bitches in season (on the date of the show) are not permitted to compete . . . American Kennel Club *Obedience Regulation*, amended to January 1, 2005. |

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES minus \$6.00 per event, will be given to the entrants of bitches in these obedience and rally trials, upon written certification by a licensed veterinarian to the effect that the bitch in question is in season on the day of the trial, if received one half hour before start of all judging on the trial date.

Rules and regulations of civil authorities and/or building or location restrictions will apply to all persons on the trial premises. This is a **SMOKE-FREE BUILDING.**

Outside exercise area is provided . . . please use gravel exercise area and on hill above gravel area. **All other areas are off-limits** Failure to pick up after your dog may result in being asked to leave the trial with no refund of entry fees.

Parking allowed only in designated areas up above. Two handicapped parking spaces are provided on the lower level, otherwise the lower level is reserved for loading and unloading only. Unattended vehicles parked on lower level will be towed.

WRIGHT COUNTY MINNESOTA KENNEL CLUB, INC., RESERVES THE RIGHT to substitute trophies/awards with one of equal or greater value.

RUNOFFS: Runoff for High Combined will not be performed until the completion of Utility A, Utility B and Open B and the awarding of those classes and final tabulation by the Show Secretary. Runoff for High in Trial will be performed after the awarding of all Regular Classes and final tabulation by the Show Secretary.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION TO ASSURE THEIR DOGS ARE FREE OF INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL PARASITES, ANY COMMUNICABLE DISEASES, AND HAVE APPROPRIATE VACCINATIONS.

PROOF OF CURRENT RABIES VACCINATION MUST BE IN THE POSSESSION OF EXHIBITORS OR HANDLERS FOR ALL DOGS AT THESE TRIALS.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
